Most economical solution for small height differentials and light loads. Can be used for trucks both above and below dock by reversing plate.

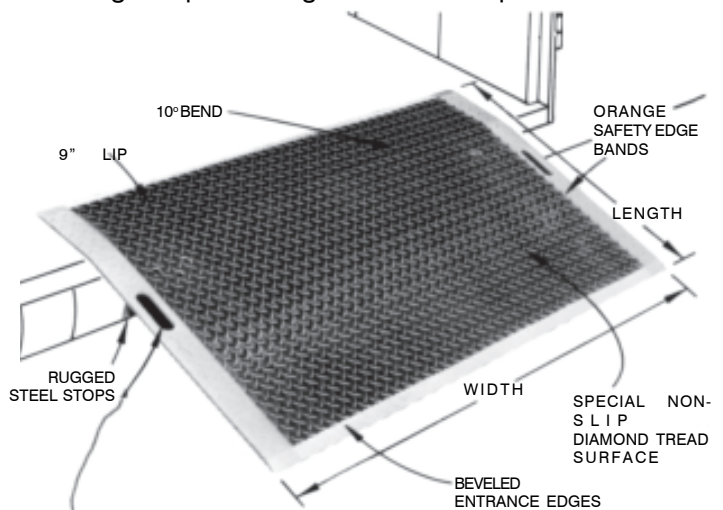
Selecting the Correct Dockplate

Step 1: Determine the maximum height differential. To do this subtract your dock height from 55", since 55" is the maximum height of most trailers. If you get refrigerated trailers in, use 59".

Step 2: Determine the capacity you require.

Step 3: Select the width that best suits your needs. Two wheel hand carts 36" wide. Pallet jacks 48-60" wide. Lift Trucks 60-72" wide. We suggest that you do not skimp on the width.

Step 4: Look in the table above for the width and height differential which you have selected. The height differential will determine the length you need. (For refrigerated trailer - need 6" longer board with 15" lip.) Then choose the proper thickness for your needs. If your requirement is significantly above the listed capacity shown, then we recommend that you purchase a dockboard with welded side rails for the desired capacity.



Hand Holes are provided on all 3/8", 7/16", & 1/2" Dockplates to comply with OSHA regulations.

On plates 60" in length or longer, two hand holes on each side will be provided.

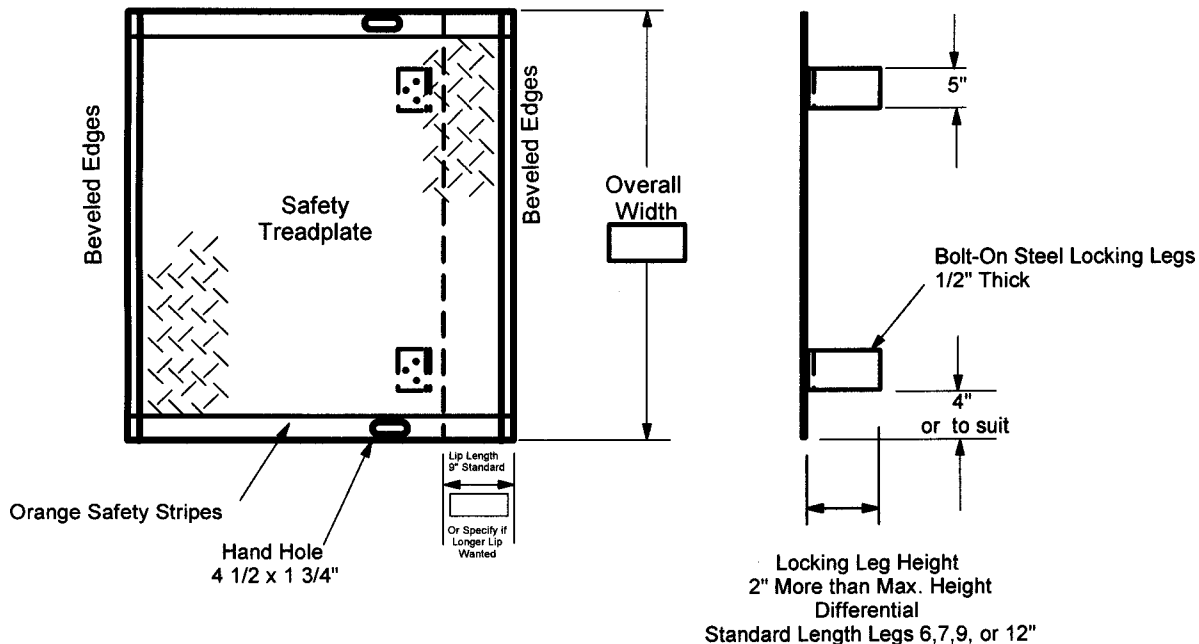

Aluminum Dockplates

- Plates have non-skid raised diamond pattern. Pattern may be put on bottom so smooth side is up.
- Plates come with beveled edges to provide smooth transition from dock to plate and prevent tire damage.
- Strong 1/2" thick x 5" wide legs help eliminate bent legs (common problem with competitors plates where they use 3/8" thick legs.)
- Bend of 10 1/2 degrees 9" from "lip side" for regular trailers, or 15" lip for refrigerated trucks. Special degree or lip length available at no additional charge, just let us know.
- Hand holes are provided on 3/8, 7/16, & 1/2" plates to comply with OSHA regulations.
- Aluminum Handles provided on 5/8 & 3/4" plates.
- Orange safety stripes are painted on sides as warning to stay away from edges.

Special note: On plates 72" long, 42" long forks are needed to lift plate with lifting pads.



Hand Holes are provided on all 3/8" & 1/2" Dockplates to comply with OSHA regulations.
 On plates 60" in length or longer, two hand holes on each side will be provided.
